Case Study #5 - Gill's story

Gill is 34 years old a mother of three children aged 6, 3 and 9 months. She lives at home with her husband who works full time. Four months ago Gill suffered a stroke which left her with paralysis down her left side which had affected her mobility, speech and memory. She requires to use a wheelchair at present and is receiving homecare three times per day to assist with dressing, bathing and using the toilet.

The social work department have secured full time nursery placements for her two youngest children and have put in place a family support worker to escort the children to and from school and nursery.

Gill has some support twice weekly from OT services looking at re-enablement skills. Her husband has been able to continue work but takes on caring responsibilities for Gill in the evenings.

Gill is struggling to cope with the change in her circumstance and feels she has lost her most important role as an active mum to her children.



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
